## 2017 YOUTH FOOTBALL REGISTRATION INFORMATION

### General Overview

3rd-5th grade tackle and 7 on 7 leagues will utilize a Fayetteville school and grade-based system. For our 3rd-4th grade tackle league, if a school has 26 players or more they could be split into two teams after the coaches from both teams meet with the recreation coordinator to establish an equal division of players. If a school has less than 22 players they could be paired up with a school or schools that find themselves in the same position.

The 5th-7th grade tackle league will utilize a draft-selection process and will refer to player skill assessments conducted by the coaches and the Boys and Girls Club staff. The mandatory skills assessment will be held at the Boys and Girls Club in Mid-August.

Participation fees cover the usage of shoulder pads, and helmets; it is the responsibility of the participant to return equipment immediately following the last game of the season. Players receive team jerseys that they get to keep. All participants are required to have proof of a physical examination that has taken place within the last year. (Physical is to be turned in upon registration)

### 7 on 7 Football

This league is designed to teach kids the fundamentals of the passing game and pass defense as well as to help with conditioning. 7 on 7 is for players entering 4th-7th grade. Practices will begin in late July with games beginning in mid-August. The season ends prior to the tackle football season.

### Tackle Football

Games will begin on or after September 9th and as a part of the NWA Boys & Girls Club Football League, ALL TEAMS WILL TRAVEL to surrounding communities for games. Practices will begin on or after the week of August 14th. Players will receive a phone call or email from their coach concerning practices before August 15th. All games will be played on Tuesdays and Saturdays and will utilize a typical 11 on 11 format.
